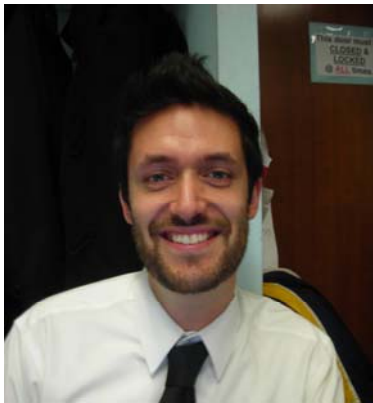




Spotlight on the staff!

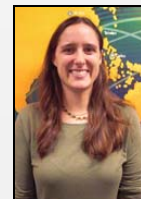
