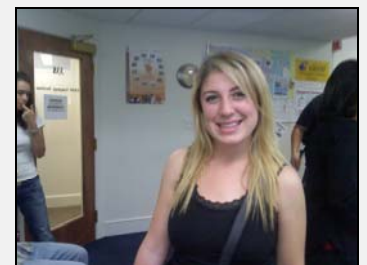
Yuri Kojima, Japan

I always do my best to let the students know the benefits of studying at GEOS Boston. Please be sure that our mutual dealing is growing.

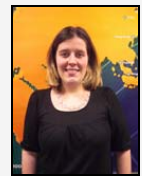

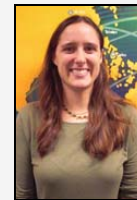

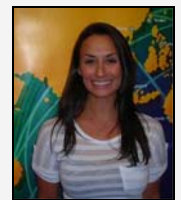
